PRIVACY POLICY

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

Global Value Investment Corp. (“GVIC”) strongly believes in protecting the confidentiality and security of information we collect about you. This notice describes our privacy policy and describes how we treat the information we receive about you.

The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the nature of the services you have engaged us to provide. This information can include:

- Name and address;
- Social Security/taxpayer ID number;
- Assets;
- Income;
- Account balances;
- Investment objectives;
- Investment activity; and
- Accounts at other institutions

How We Collect Information

We collect your personal information, for example, when you provide us with certain information necessary to allow us the ability to evaluate your request for our services, provide investment advice, and process transactions in your account. We may also use that information to offer you other services we provide that may meet your investment needs.

All financial companies need to share personal information to run their everyday business. Below we list some of the reasons financial companies share their clients’ personal information; whether GVIC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How We Protect Information

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

We do not, nor have we ever, sell your personal information to anyone. We treat all information about current and former clients, and their accounts, in a confidential manner. Our employees may access client information and provide it to third parties only when completing a transaction at your request or providing GVIC's services to you.

At your request, we may disclose information to attorneys, accountants, securities professionals, and others to assist us, or them, in providing services to you. We may also share information with companies that perform services on our behalf, such as the companies that we hire to perform administrative services. Companies we hire to provide support services are not allowed to use your personal information for their own purposes. We may be required to make additional disclosures as permitted by law.

We also maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect information. Employees and our professional service representatives are required to comply with our established information confidentiality provisions.

Access to and Correction of Information

Generally, upon your written request, we will make information in our possession available for your review. Information collected in connection with, or in anticipation of, any claim or legal proceeding will not be made available.

If your personal information with us becomes inaccurate, or if you need to make a change to that information, please contact us so we can update our records.
